1. The following rules are to allow for a safe, pleasant, and enjoyable pool experience for the property owners of the Grand Oaks Summit Owners Association. Public health concerns, common sense, and common courtesies to all residents are taken into consideration in these rules. Any member violating these rules will result in the Grand Oaks Summit Owners Association having the right to suspend their pool privileges. A second suspension will result in the termination of pool privileges for the remainder of the pool season.
2. Pools are for the exclusive use of owners, resident family members, and lessees with rights of ownership. Owners are to accompany guests at all times and assume responsibility and liability for them. The maximum allowable number of guests is six per visit. Unauthorized users of this facility will be considered trespassers and are subject to security and/or police intervention. The Grand Oaks Summit Owners Association is not responsible for guests using the facility.
3. All members are to gain access to the pool area with their access card. Members shall not leave the gates open or allow others without access cards to gain entry to the facility. Members shall not give their access cards to non-members for the purpose of allowing them permanent access to the facilities.
4. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult age 18 or older. An adult must accompany and are responsible for a maximum of four children under the age of 14. Groups of youths, ages 14 – 17, are limited to four in number. Groups of five or more youths must be accompanied by an adult.
5. Children who are not potty trained must wear plastic pants **AND** swim diapers when in the pools. All disposable diapers must be disposed of properly. Members will be charged for any costs attributable to an “accident” occurring due to a child wearing regular diapers in the pool.
6. Pool hours are 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily unless closed for necessary maintenance. The pool will be open for recreational swimming between the hours of 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Lap Swim hours are 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and Quiet Time is 9:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily. Anyone disrupting the neighboring houses during these times will be asked to stop, or they will need to leave the premises. All members and their guests must vacate the pool facility at 10:00 p.m. Persons violating this rule will be considered trespassers and are subject to security and/or police intervention.
7. All persons must take a cleansing shower before entering the pool. Residents are responsible for their family members and guests to adhere to this rule.
8. No person with a communicable disease transmittable via water can use the pool.
9. No person under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs can use the pool.
10. No running or engaging in horseplay, shoving, pushing, throwing a hard ball, fence climbing, or profanity is permitted in or around the pool.
11. Diving into the pool is not allowed at any time as the pools are not deep enough.
12. Smoking, glass containers, skateboarding, bicycles, roller blades, scooters (motorized or non-motorized), or pets are not allowed inside the pool area.
13. All members are responsible for cleaning up the pool area that they and their guests use, including closing the umbrellas, wiping down tables, and disposing of trash properly. This includes taking home personal property (pool toys, towels, etc.).

14. Rafts, inflatables, and floats large enough to hold two people are prohibited from all pools. Smaller floatation devices and pool toys are prohibited from the Hot Tub, excluding safety devices for children who cannot swim. All floatation devices must be rinsed before placing them in the pools. Jumping onto floatation devices is strictly prohibited. All materials with glitter or any substance that can come off in the pool are also prohibited.

15. A lost and found container is provided for found toys and articles. If you are missing an item of value, please contact a member of the Recreation Committee.

16. Destruction of property, personal or otherwise, is strictly prohibited.

17. Members are prohibited from holding parties that exceed 20 persons, and there must be a minimum of one adult for every four children under the age of 14.

18. Adults and children over the age of 4 must use the restrooms for clothing changes. All persons in the pool area should be clothed at all times. Skinny-dipping and public nudity are prohibited. Persons violating this rule are subject to security and/or police intervention.

19. The Grand Oaks Summit Owners Association assumes no responsibility for accidents, injuries, or loss of personal property. Each person who enters the pool area does so at their own risk.

20. All pool patrons must have on swimwear. The type of swimwear is up to the discretion of the individual. This is a diverse and global community with different ideas of modesty. Everyone must be appropriately covered at all times.

Allowed at the pool: Any article of clothing that was designed for swim use that is chlorine proof and colorfast, one piece bathing suit, two piece bathing suit, swim shorts, swim skirts, swimming trunks, swim shirt, full swim suit, wet suit.

Not allowed at the pool - including but not limited to: Underwear, sports bras, cotton clothing, jeans, gym shorts, jackets, t-shirt, land shoes, socks, see-through bathing suits when wet, clothing with buttons or zippers, any type of street clothes

Self-Assessment of attire.....it is not allowed if: You would wear your attire to the gym, during land sports or running, your swim trunks have no netting/lining, you wear underwear with your swim trunks, your spandex can be used for land sports, it is bought in the underwear department

You will be asked to change or leave if: You are in unacceptable swimwear, you have been wearing your swimwear for land exercising immediately prior to pool use, you are wearing anything cotton, you are not appropriately covered
